The Dyer Island Conservation Trust (DICT) has been established for:

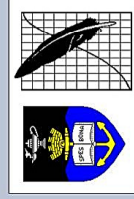
- ✓ Conservation, rehabilitation or protection of the natural environment

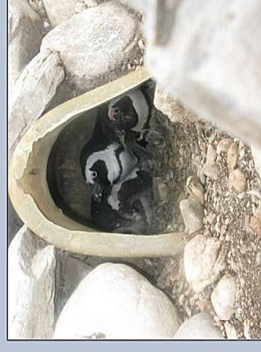
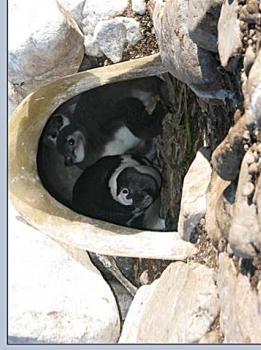
